

HOW TO BECOME A COMPETITION COACH

How to become a Competition Coach (Formerly Level 2)

You will need to have been a Club Coach (Level 1) for a minimum of 2 years. This time frame may be reconsidered if Recognised Prior Learning can be proven.

Contact your State Coaching Director for the next available Competition Coaching Course in your state. In Western Australia the State Coaching Director is Christine Alexander

Once accredited with the Australian Sports Commission, you will be registered as a competition coach for four years. You will be supplied with a wallet size ID card with your details.

Renewal

When your four years are due to expire you will need to be re-assessed. You will be reissued with a new ID card for the next four years.
